

INVENTION DIORAMA



Goal: Using art, students will create a diorama showcasing their favorite invention and the different ways in which it can be used.

Activity: Invention Diorama

Materials: Book “Have You Thanked an Inventor Today”, and/or “Have You Thanked a Kidventor Today?”, glue, scissors, shoebox, marker

DIRECTIONS: Students should pick an invention from the book. Next they should find images that represent ways that their favorite invention can be used. Figurines can be used as well. To find images, students can look in magazines, print off internet or even draw the images. After the images are found, students should cut them out and secure them in the shoebox. Dioramas can be used as classroom decorations.
