Goal: Students will build writing and vocabulary skills by writing a letter to their favorite inventor.


Activity: Letter Writing

Materials: "Have You Thanked an Inventor Today?" and/or "Have You Thanked a Kidventor Today?" picture book, Graphic Letter Organizer, Paper, Pencil or Pen
