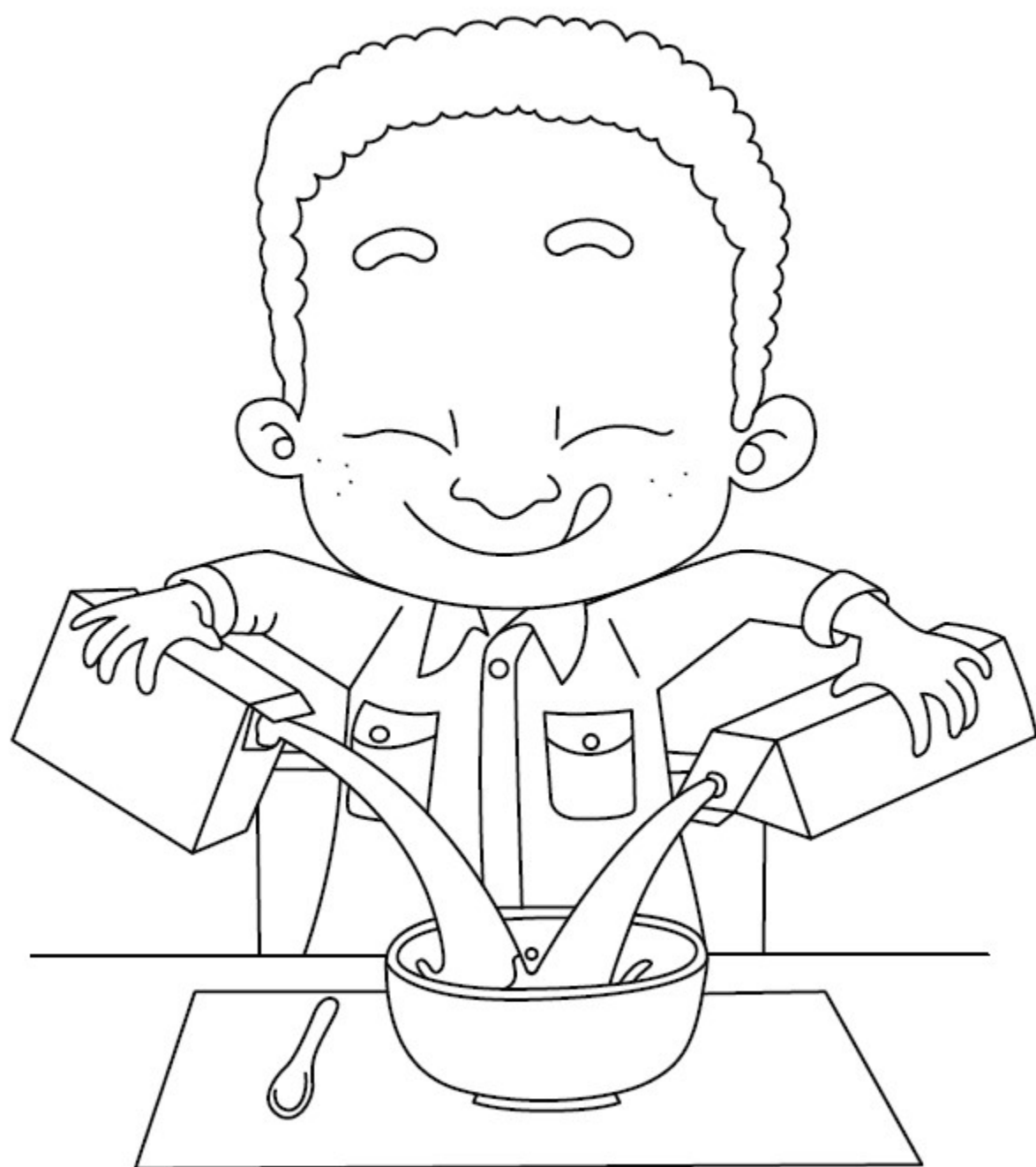


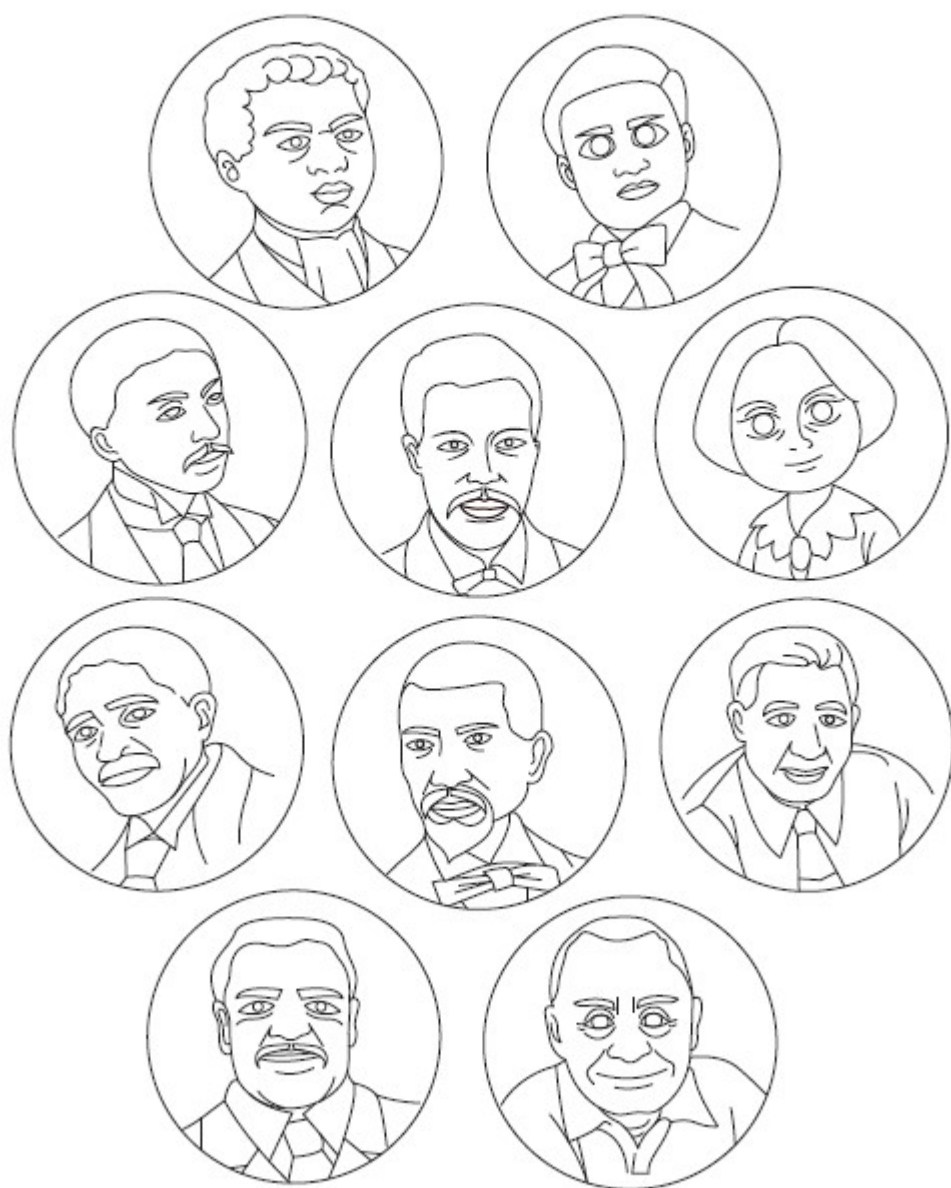

HOW MANY INVENTORS DO YOU COUNT?

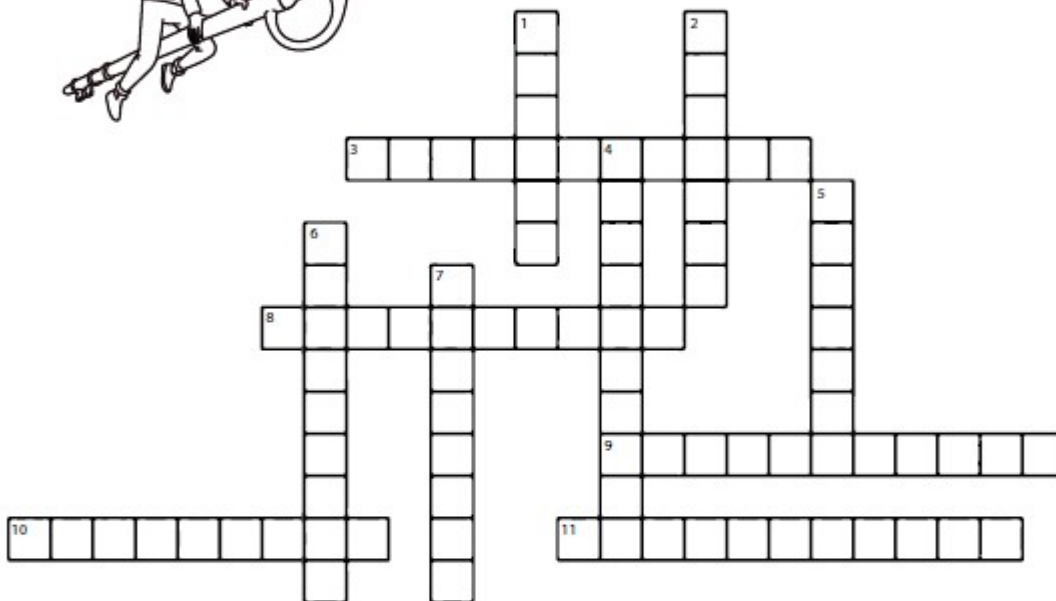
